

Recording a Screencast Using QuickTime Player


1. Open QuickTime Player in your *Applications Folder*



2. Click on File → New Screen Recording



3. Click on the Record button.



Note: The triangle allows you to record sound or record without sound.


- **4.** Choose the area you want to record by dragging your mouse from corner to corner...or, simply press anywhere to record the full screen.
- **5.** When you are finished, press the *Stop* button.

Recording a Videocast Using QuickTime Player

1. Open QuickTime Player in your *Applications Folder*



2. Click on File → New Movie Recording



3. To record, click on the *Record* button. To stop recording, click on the *Stop* button.





Recording a Podcast Using QuickTime Player

1. Open QuickTime Player in your *Applications Folder*



2. Click on File → New Audio Recording



3. To record, click on the *Record* button. To stop recording, click on the *Stop* button.

Editing in QuickTime Player

1. Click on Edit → Trim



- 2. Listen and/or watch your Podcast, Videocast and Screencast.
- 3. Drag the Yellow Bars at the beginning and end of your clip.



4. Click on Trim when you are finished.

Sharing or Saving in QuickTime Player

1. Click on *Share* → *YouTube* (iTunes or iMovie are other options)
